About **People Like Us** by Michael Erickson:

Commissioned by Plays for Living (TM) in 1994 to address diversity and racism in the workplace; the play quickly became one of Plays for Living's most popular programs in a variety of venues for well-over a decade. **People Like Us** explores challenging and highly charged issues that confront society today. Set around a multi-cultural workplace and related locales, the play shows subtle, not-so-subtle and systematic ways that racism plays out in the characters' lives. There are no easy solutions; however, the play sets the stage for discussing the many actions that may be taken to successfully address the issues. Not only awareness raising, the play is a quality theatrical event that is also a productive tool for social change.

Responsibilities

Artreach will:

- Supply the fully-produced video production of the play; video allows for flexibility in presentation dates as well as enabling a virtual option if necessary.
- Provide two facilitators of diverse race and ethnicity to facilitate the discussion.
- Work with your agency to customize the post-performance discussion in order to meet the agency's goals for the program.
- Supply an informational letter and a graphic for you to use.

Presenting organization will:

- Market and promote the program to its audience (using information and graphic we supply).
- Provide A/V and technical equipment.
- Provide the facility and seating for up to 50 guests.
- Handle reservations and provide Artreach with attendance information for its reporting.
